

ORIENTATION VISIT FOR 1ST MSW STUDENTS SEPTEMBER TO OCTOBER 2019



1. Orientation Visit to Snehadaan

The students of 1st year MSW had visited Snehadaan which is working with People Living with HIV (PLHIV). The students were explained of the organization's activities and programs. Students received better exposure.

2. Orientation Visit to Stree Jagruti Samithi

The Students from 1st year MSW visited Stree Jagruti Samithi which works for Domestic Workers. Students were made aware of problems of Domestic Workers and Rights for protection of them.

3. Orientation Visit to Vimochana

The MSW students visited Vimochana which works for Rights of Women. The Students attended the session which was interactive. Students explored rights and privileges of women and how the intervention has to be done with professional support.

4. Orientation Visit to Jeevasarthakate

The students of 1st year MSW visited Jeevasarthakate, an organ Transplant Coordinating agency for Karnataka. Students had exposure to Organ Transplantation and Act governing it.

5. Orientation Visit to Child Rights Trust

MSW Students from 1st Year have visited Child Rights Trust. The students were made aware about the Rights of Children and how the Trust works for rescuing and protecting children and how they are managing Child Helpline.

6. Orientation Visit to HSR Layout Police Station

The Students visited Police Station at HSR Layout and explored into the duties of police station in maintenance of peace and order in the public and role of educated civilians.

7. Orientation Visit to Talaash Association

The students visited Talaash Association which is working for rescue and protection of Child and Women Trafficking. The Coordinator of the Agency explained the students on how they work and the process of tracking, tracing, rescuing and protecting the trafficked child and women. The way they coordinate with police and legal support.

8. Orientation Visit to Souharda Family Counseling Centre

The Students visited the agency which works as Family Counseling Centre. Students explored the activities and process of counseling and major family dynamics requiring the counseling.

9. Orientation Visit to Mathruchaya

The Students have paid visit to Mathruchaya, the Agency which works as adoption centre and geriatric care and old age home. The students had the exposure on adoption rules and procedure, geriatric care.

10. Orientation Visit to Children Home for Boys

The students visited Children Home and learnt about maintenance of children in need of care and protection. The students visited inmates in the Home and observed their agency operational wing, the objectives and provisions of JJ act, CARA and Integrated Child protection activities.

11. Orientation Visit to Abalashrama

The students made a visit to Abalashrama, an agency functioning for abandoned, destitute, orphan girls, women, their rehabilitation, resettlement and empowerment. The students attended the session on explanation of meaning of abandonment, destitution, and

orphan. They informed the students about the services they provide for women and girl children at Abalashrama.

12.Orientation Visit to Spastic Society of Karnataka

The students visited Spastic Society of Karnataka, NGO dedicated to the welfare of persons with Neuro-Muscular and Developmental Disabilities. The students attended explanatory session on Developmental disabilities and visited the teaching and training rooms and observed conditions and activities of children.
