Mandated COVID Negative RT-PCR Certificates from all Students

The Oxford College: kick-starts offline classes for the first time since marched 2020 when the Pandemic hit, college invited students, faculty and staff member to get tested free in college campus. As the state government has mandated COVID negative RT-PCR certificates from all students who want to attend offline classes, “Testing” on campus has been active since November-17, till now over 4900 students have been tested. Arranged by Bruhat Bengaluru MahanagaraPalike [BBMP]. The Oxford College has been tie up with Government Hospital Agra, constantly monitor by DrLokesh who does weekly round, with sixth member actively working at campus, Abhisekh perform Data-entry, Yasodha, MadhuKiran and Sohil are swab collector and Nitin&Priyanka perform Data entry operator. Collecting test sample from 9:30 am to packaging all samples till 4:00 pm, on daily basis approximately 58-60 samples were tested and will continue collecting till marched 2021 or may be extend with situations.

So far college has not reported any Positive case, which has been a win-win situation for college itself. Students have to bring COVID negative RT-PCR certificates and parent consent letter to enter college.

College have been sanitizing campus, displaying COVID etiquette posters. College witnessed 20% to 30% student at recent day of opening , while more student turn up with passing days; With slow pace and staggered approach oxford college started a new academic year of 2021, also close monitoring all the government guidelines according to COVID-19 Protocols.
