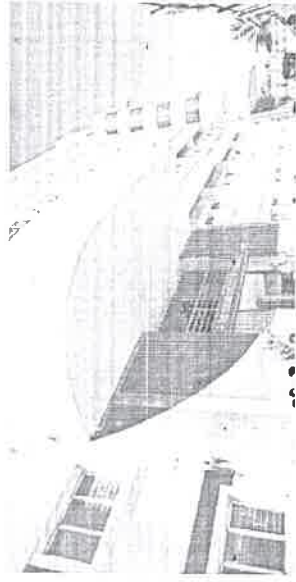

2. • Collection of keywords and search query building
• Collection of the documents from the search query and taxonomy formulation
3. • Sample analysis on the taxonomy
• Client review and feedback on the taxonomy and search query
4. • Finalizing search query and taxonomy
• Starting analysis
5. • Finishing analysis
• Marking relevant patent and non-patent documents
6. • Structuring report
• High/Medium/Low ranked patent marked
