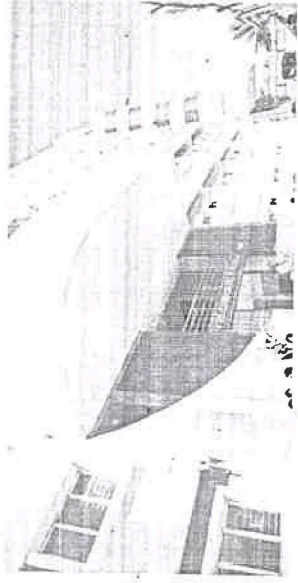

PREAMBLE

The Department of Pharmacy Practice conducted the seminar on "**Implementing Ethical Research in Laboratory Animal Facilities as per CPCSEA Guidelines**" for the students, and teaching faculties. There were totally around 45 participants. Dr. Parthasarathy. G, Professor, The Oxford College of Pharmacy, Bangalore delivered the lecture.

Committee for the Purpose of Control and Supervision of Experiments on Animals (CPCSEA) are a set of guidelines which focuses on humane treatment of animals and ethical conduct of scientific experiments in animals. The seminar will provide insight into CPCSEA guidelines.

The content delivered in the seminar is as follows:

The speaker started addressing the topic. He interacted with the participants regarding CPCSEA guidelines for laboratory animal facility, treatment and control of disease, personal hygiene, animal husbandry, personnel training, SOP's , surveillance, transport of lab animals.

CPCSEA is formed by the Act of the Indian parliament under the prevention of cruelty to animals act, 1960. Role of CPCSEA is to monitor animal experiments through ethics committees set up in institutions (IAEC).

Additionally, he discussed about goals of CPCSEA which includes to promote the human care of animals used in research, to provide specifications that will enhance animal well-being and quality of research. They have activities regarding approval of animal house facilities, permission of committee for conducting experiments. As well as he discussed the CPCSEA guidelines for veterinary care, it includes care, quarantine, separation of animals. Also discussed regarding procurement of animals done from established commercial animal vendors. Use of transport containers of appropriate size and in animal husbandry discussed regarding adequate ventilation, easy access to food and water and also regarding SOP's.



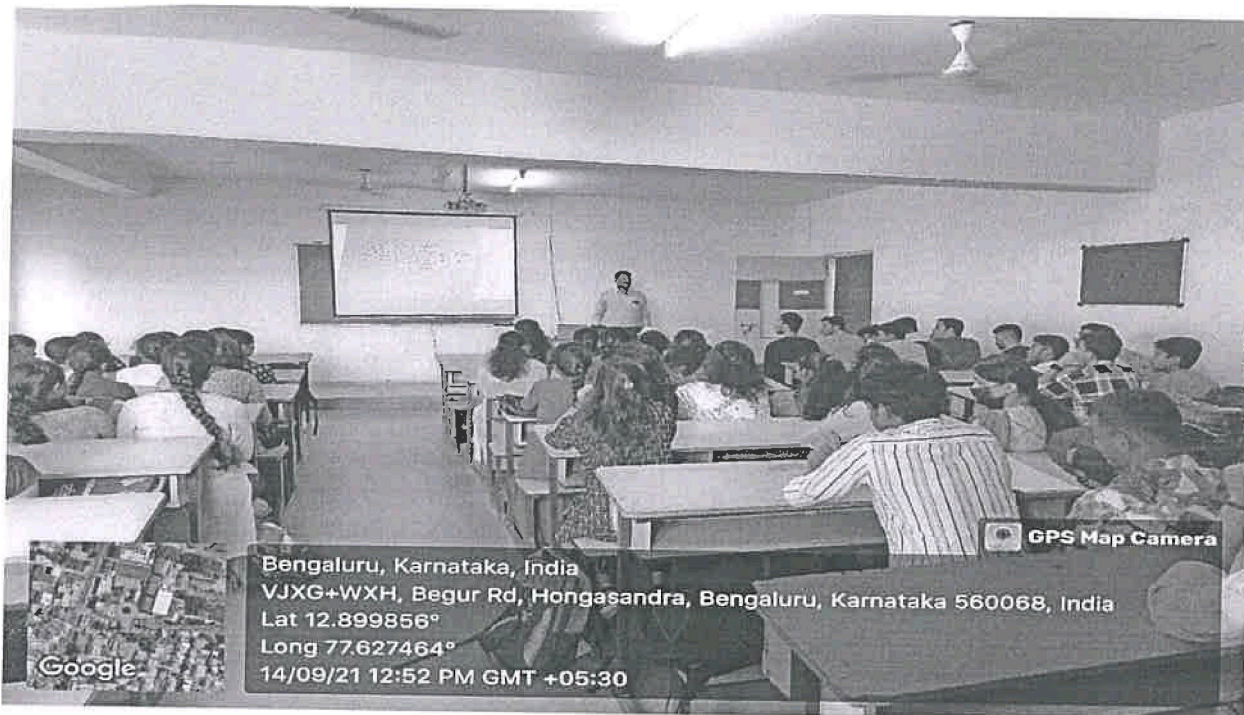
