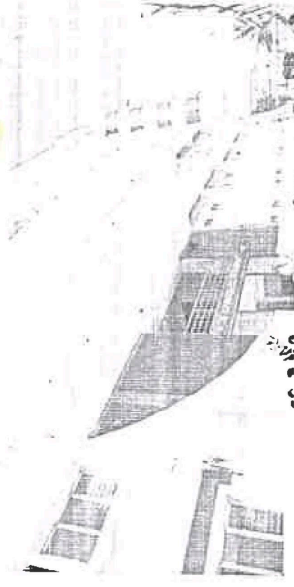

PREAMBLE

The Department of Pharmaceutics conducted the seminar on "The Declaration of Helsinki and its importance in upholding ethics in Medical Research" for the students, and teaching faculties. There were 39 participants in the current seminar. Dr. Gururaj S Kulkarni, Professor, The Oxford College of Pharmacy, Bangalore delivered the lecture.

The Declaration of Helsinki is an important document that sets out the ethical principles for medical research involving human subjects. It is a foundation stone in research ethics, which safeguards participants of medical studies.

The content delivered in the seminar is as follows:

The speaker interacted regarding a set of principles for the conduct of human experimentations for the medical professionals developed by the World Medical Association (WMA). Helsinki Declaration was originally adopted in 1964 in Helsinki, Finland and thereafter it has undergone seven revisions. The document consists of 12 segments, each describing specific principles. These segments are discussed below in detail along with the original statement.

Also discussed regarding basic principles of medical research, which states medical research involving human subjects must conform to generally accepted scientific principles; be based on a thorough knowledge of the scientific literature, other relevant sources of information, and on adequate laboratory and where appropriate animal experimentation. Also about medical care, on which talked about equitable distribution, community distribution, intersectoral distribution, appropriate technology.

Additionally, the speaker addressed that there are 10 specific areas within the Declaration of Helsinki. This includes consideration of risks, burdens, benefits, offering special protection for vulnerable groups and individuals, focusing on ethics, protection of privacy as well as confidentiality, obtaining informed consent, usage of placebo, post-trial revisions and dissemination of research findings.

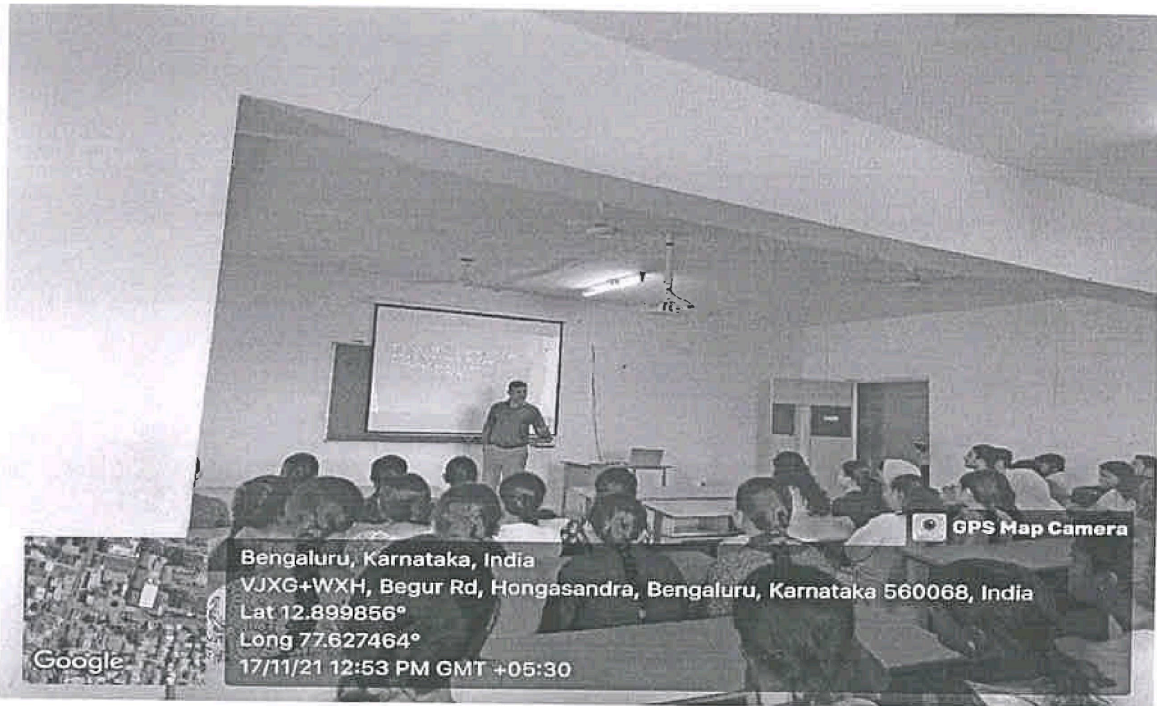

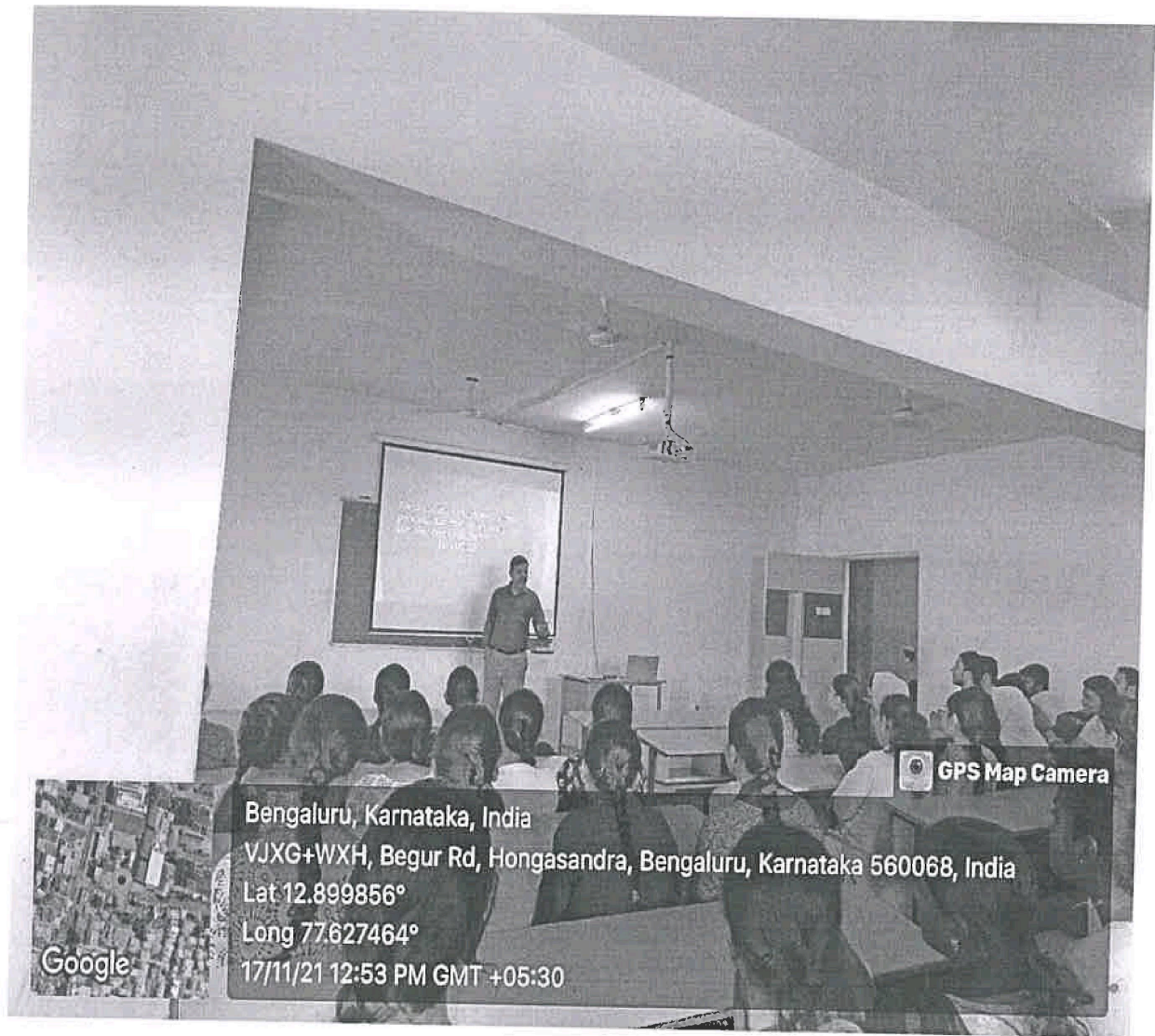

OUTCOME

There were 39 participants in the seminar. The seminar helped the participants understand the ethical principles outlined in the Declaration of Helsinki. They learned about the importance of obtaining informed consent from human subjects, ensuring their privacy and confidentiality, the role of ethics committees and such other important areas in the ethical review process. The seminar also discussed the challenges and limitations of implementing ethical principles in medical research, particularly in resource-limited settings. It emphasized the need for ongoing education and training on ethical principles for all individuals involved in medical research. Overall, it helped to promote ethical conduct in medical research involving human subjects.
