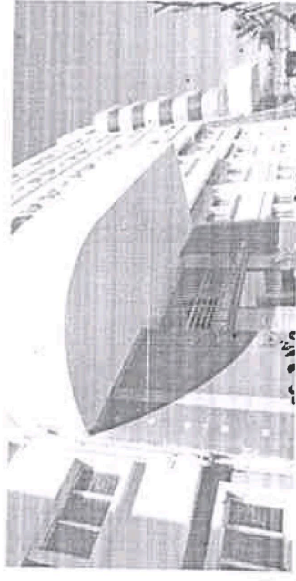

## PREAMBLE

The Department of Pharmacology conducted the seminar on "Understanding Patents and Intellectual Property Rights" for the teaching faculties and students. There were totally 75 participants. Dr. Noopur Srivastava, Associate Professor, The Oxford College of Pharmacy, Bangalore delivered the lecture.

### The content delivered in the seminar is as follows:

The seminar was initiated by Dr. Karthik, Organizing Secretary by welcoming participants to the seminar. Speaker Dr. Noopur Srivastava started with Intellectual property refers to works that are the result of unique intellectual or creative labor. It is a tangible or communicative consequence of literary, artistic, or scientific work, and it might take the form of intellectual, material, or cultural goods. The legal rights that exist in those creations are known as intellectual property rights (IPR). The amount of money spent on R&D in India each year is enormous, despite the fact that locals file just 20% of all filed patents.

Then she explained about patents. Patent are a type of Intellectual property (IP) which protects any idea or technological advance, thereby which grants the solitary rights to its owner for a limited period. Patent can be obtained by filing an application in the respective patent office with meeting the patentability criterias. The herbal medicine inventions for patent protection can be classified in four types viz., Formulation Patents on Herbal Medicine which involves new dosage form and technology to get best therapeutic benefits, Combination Patents on Herbal Medicine which includes new or alternative herbal drug and/or herbal drug preparations which can target the same indication, Process Patents on Herbal Medicine which includes new methods which can be patented in the field of herbal medicine, and lastly New Indication of Herbal Drug and Herbal Medicine where a known herbal drug has a new indication in preventing or treating specific diseases. Patents can support inventors and improve lives in many ways- they recognize and reward inventors for successful inventions, when new technology comes onto the market, society as a whole stand to benefit, help further finance technological research and development. She conveyed the landmark example of The Neem Patent case to the participants and the complexities surrounding IP rights

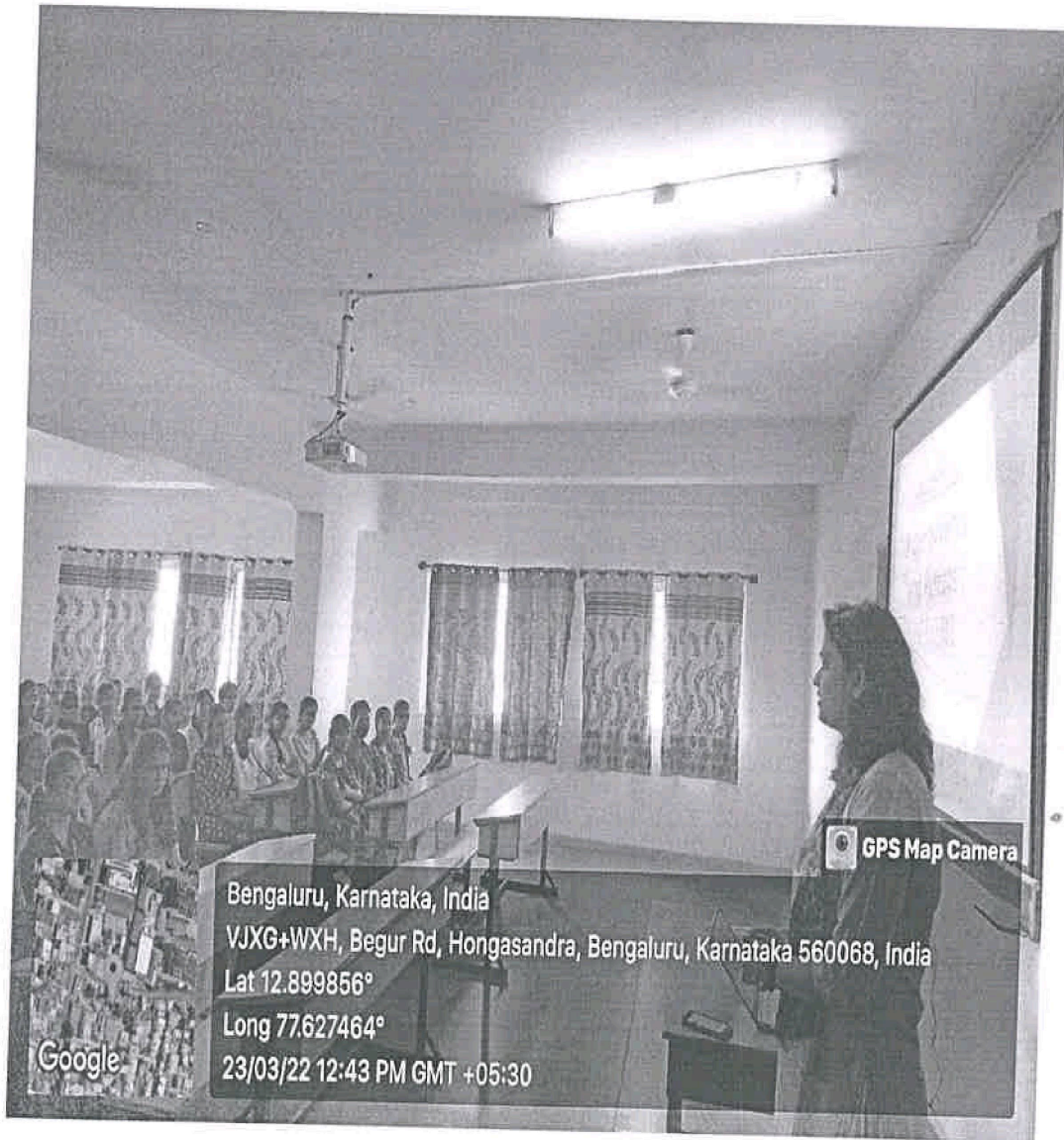

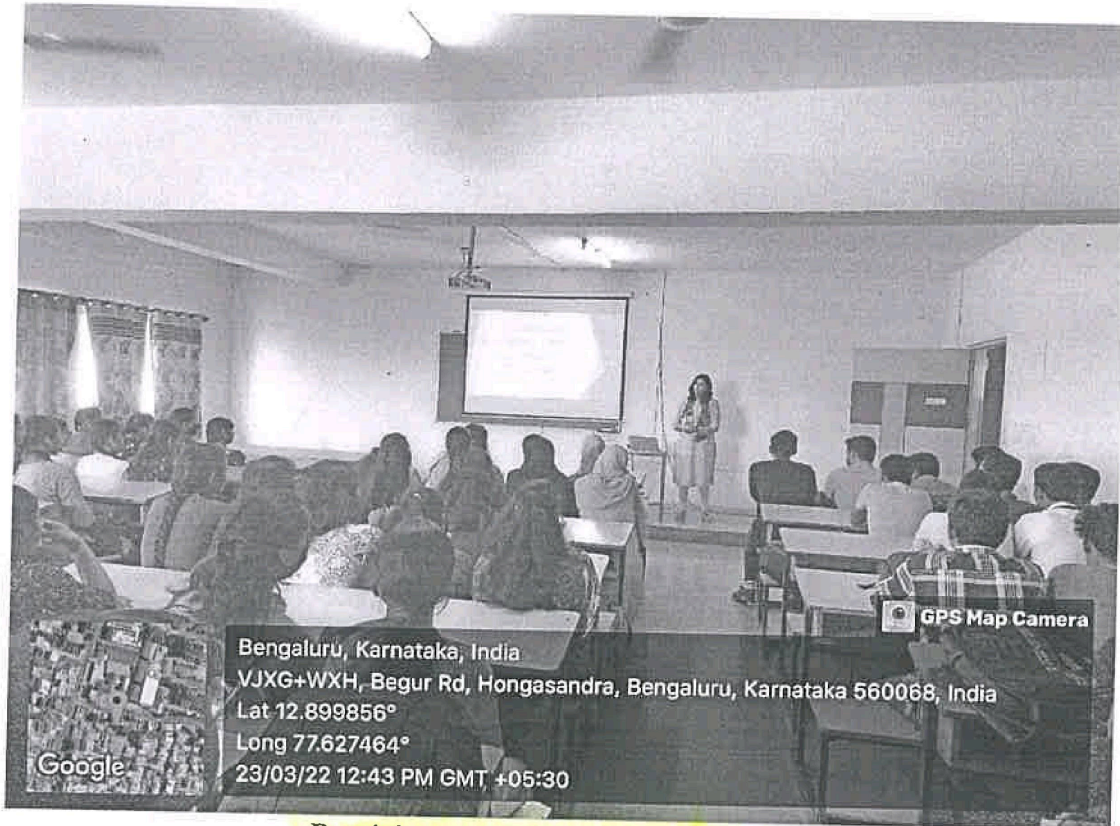
