
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PREAMBLE

Dr G Parthasarathy, HOD of Pharmacist concluded the webinar with Vote of Thanks. e-certificates were distributed to all participants.














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Mr. Vishal Chaudhari explaining to the participants about India- A favourite destination for clinical research



Mr. Vishal Chaudhari explaining to the participants about Clinical Trial Management







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Mr. Vishal Chaudhari explaining to the participants about Clinical Data Management


