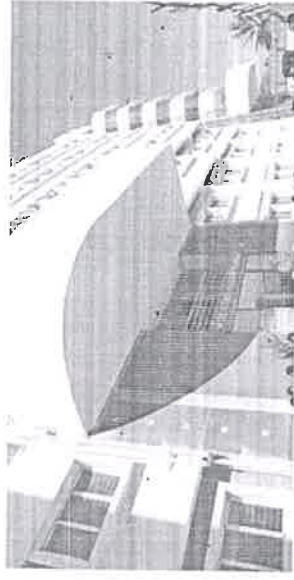

### **The content delivered in the seminar is as follows:**

The resource person began the session by discussing regarding autonomy, beneficence, double effect, informed consent, confidentiality, truth telling, importance of communication, referral, cultural concerns, vendor relationship, treatment of family members, ethics committees. A total of 20 students had participated.

In detail they discussed regarding ethics committees. An institution's research ethics committee aims to safeguard the welfare, dignity, and safety of the participants, ensure that ethically approved research is conducted in line with the approved protocol. A duty of a health professional is to be honest with their patients, Autonomy – is an ethical principle that is widely recognized as meaning self determination and self governance over ones action.

The goal of culturally competent healthcare services is to provide the highest quality of care to every patients, regardless of race, ethnicity, cultural background or literacy. Good communication skills play a vital role in healthcare field and these skills are

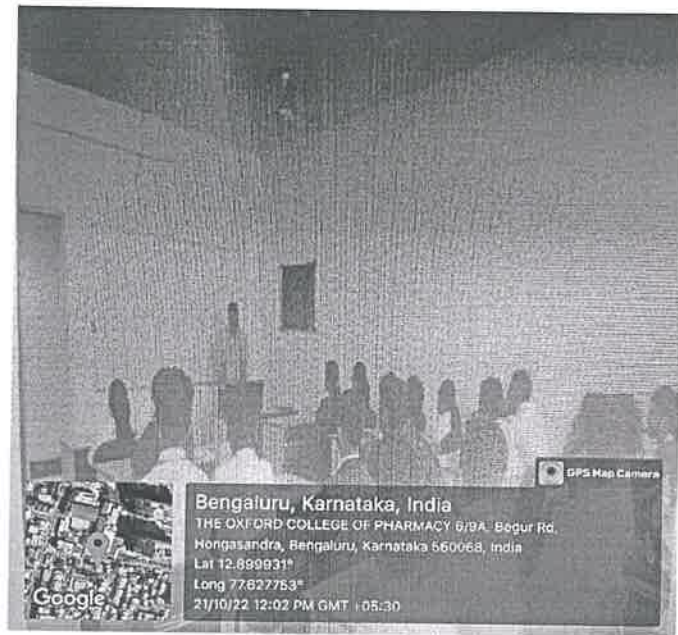
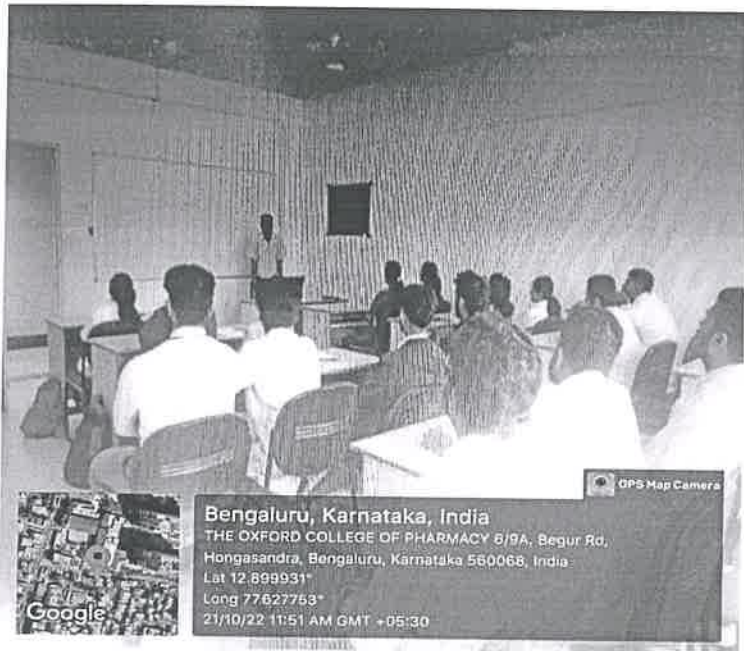
