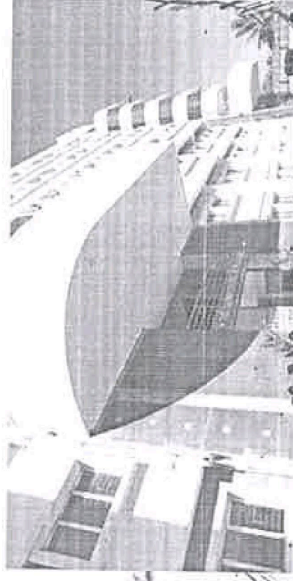

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PREAMBLE

The Department of Pharmacognosy organized a compelling and enlightening workshop on Basic Course in Research Methodology, which commenced promptly at 9 AM. The resource persons, Dr Seema Pradeep and Dr Shruthi Eshwar brought their profound expertise to the occasion, lending a significant academic gravitas to the proceedings. Mrs Suma Varghese and Dr Sheba Baby John did an admirable job of comparing the event, while Mrs Amrita's soulful invocation song added a spiritual dimension to the occasion.

The dignitaries on the dais, including Dr. Padma M Paarakh, Principal of The Oxford College of Pharmacy and the organizing secretary along with speaker ceremoniously lit the lamp, adding to the event's grandeur. Dr. Kambhoja, the organizing secretary, lucidly outlined the workshop's objectives to the 30 enthusiastic participants, who were eager to learn and grow.

Learning is a never-ending process. In context to this, the current workshop was conducted for the faculties to achieve academic excellence. For conducting research effectively, the following key points are to be considered viz., course overview, course objectives, learning, course content. The resource persons provided valuable insights in this workshop.

The content delivered in the program is as follows:

Day 1

The inaugural workshop session commenced with a pre-test administered by Dr. Seema Pradeep. The results of this test, which focused on participants' understanding of education which was used to tailor the subsequent discussions and activities. Dr. Pradeep then expounded upon the program's objectives and provided a comprehensive definition of education. The session was then adjourned for a brief tea break.

Upon resumption of the session, the dynamic Dr. Shruthi Eshwar, known for her interactive teaching style, took the reins. She delved into the intricacies of Bloom's taxonomy and Guilbert's Hierarchy theory and assigned group tasks 1 and 2, fostering active participation. The session was then adjourned for a lunch break.



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Post-lunch, Dr. Shruthi Eshwar resumed the session and expounded upon Adult Learning principles and Teaching-Learning methods. Dr. Seema Pradeep then conducted a session on microteaching and assigned group task 3a, appreciating the audience's active involvement. The first day's session concluded with a high tea.

Day 2

On the second day of the session, Dr Seema Pradeep kicked things off with a review and preview of what was to come. She then discussed the importance of effective educational communication and teaching learning media. During group task 3b, the delegates tested their new found knowledge.

Later, Dr Seema Pradeep discussed the art of lesson planning, followed by a well-deserved tea break. After the break, Dr Shruthi Eshwar took over and delved into the principles of student assessment. Group task 4 tested the delegates' understanding, and a post-test was given to assess their progress. The session then adjourned for lunch.

After lunch, the delegates were split into two groups for a microteaching session, with Dr Seema Pradeep and Dr Shruthi Eshwar leading one group each. All the delegates gave PowerPoint presentations on microteaching, and valuable feedback was provided. Finally, the valedictory function commenced, with Dr Kambhoja, the organizing secretary, giving a conclusive report and inviting all dignitaries to the dais.

We expressed our heartfelt appreciation to all the participants for their active involvement and valuable contributions. Mrs.Sona Mariam Panicker had delivered the vote of thanks, and certificates were distributed to all the delegates. 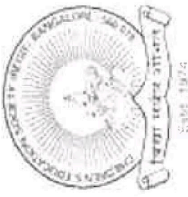
