ERP Training programs were conducted periodically for teaching and non-teaching staff.

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Finance and Accounts:

The institution used the Talley and JUNO ERP package for e-Governance of the Finance and Accounts department. Various Modules of this Package supports for the fee payment, receipt generation and financial report generation. Purchases of all consumable and non-consumable items are processed through JUNO; Budget proposals are submitted through JUNO ERP. Finance and accounts were also managed by Tally/Sharada IT & Hospitality Services.

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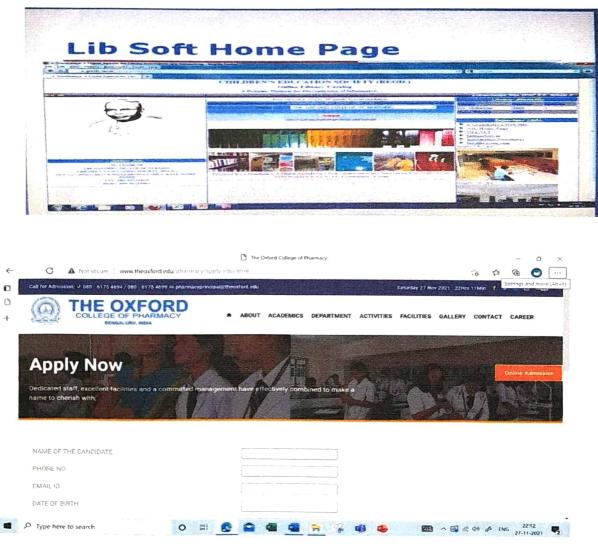
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Student Admissions and Support:

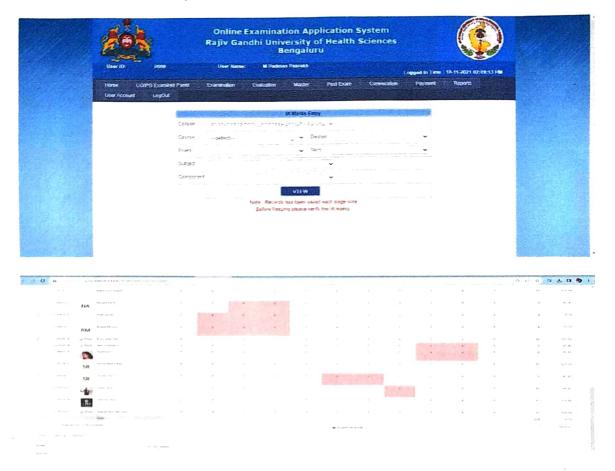

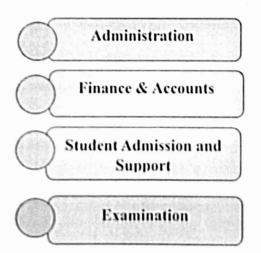

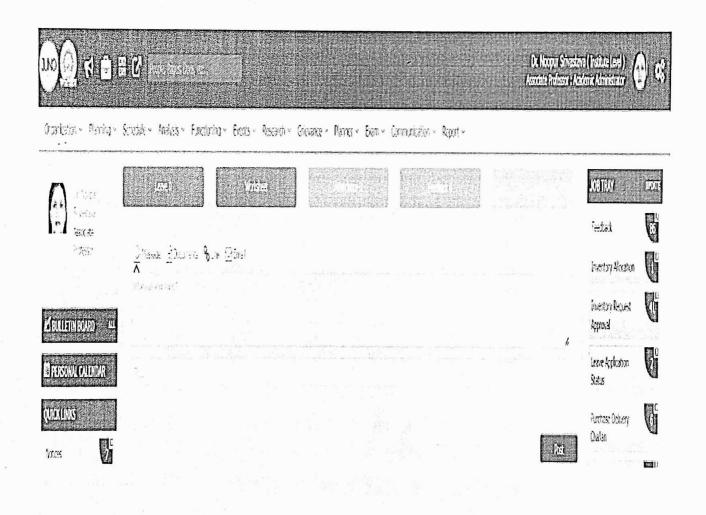


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Administration:

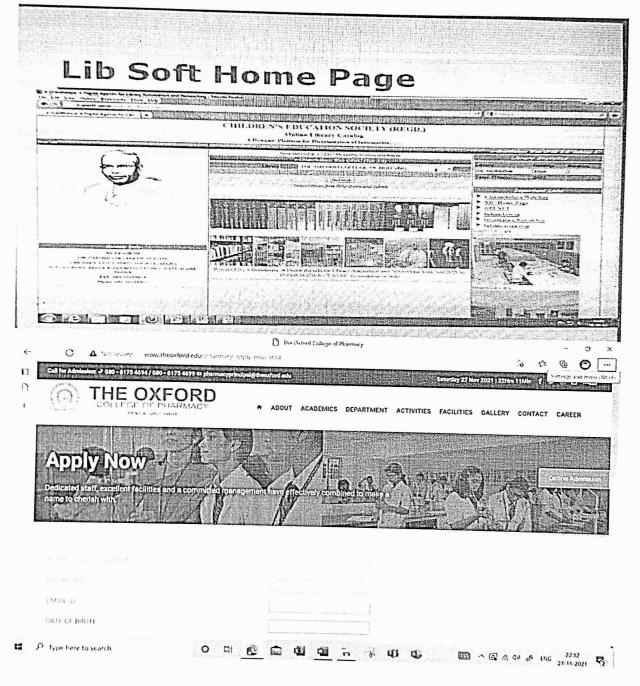




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Student admission and Support:

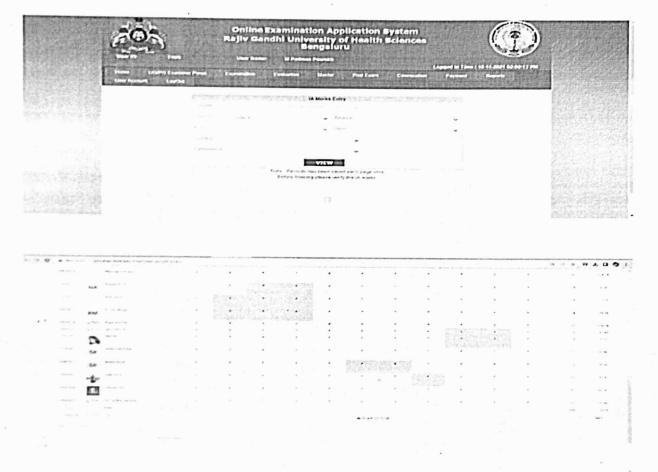




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Examination:

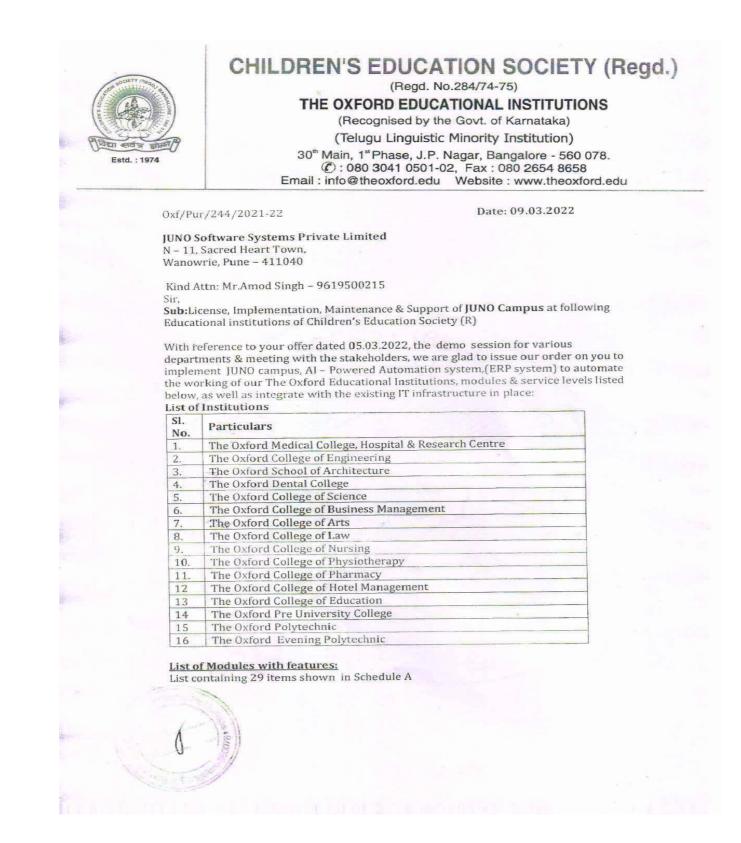

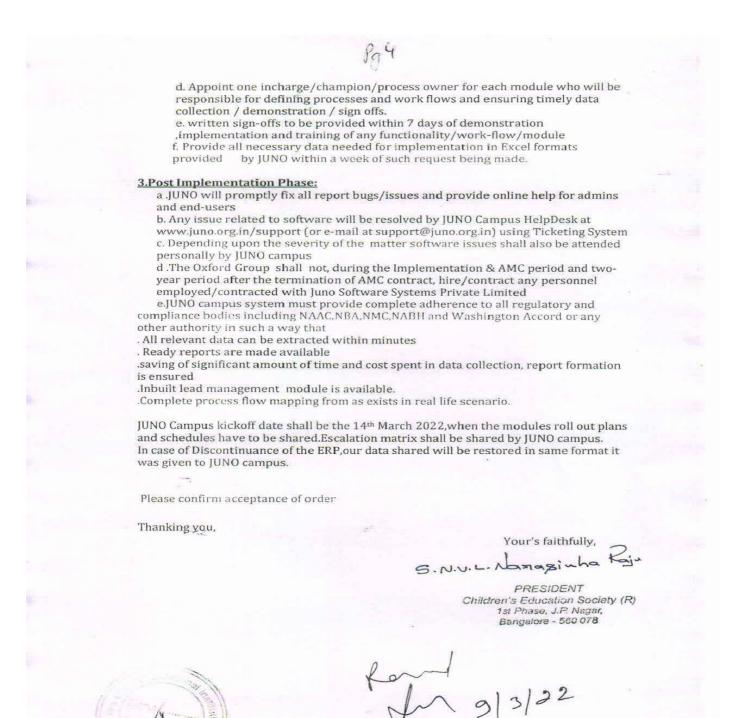

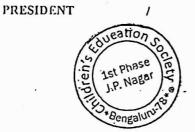
