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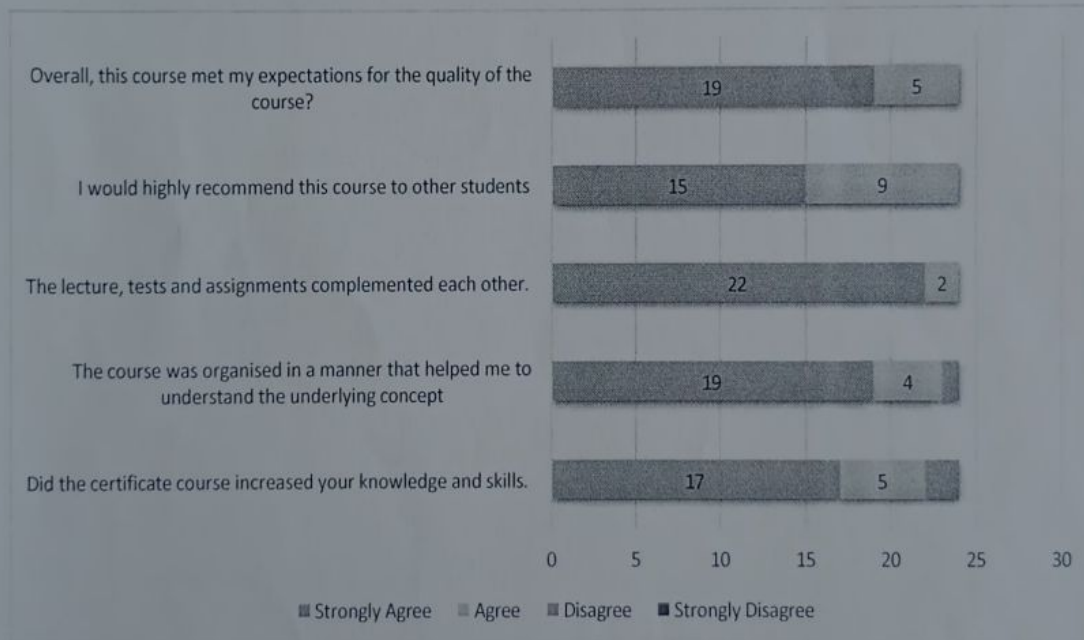

Graph 1: Student feedback

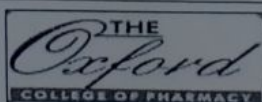

After the Second Sessional Examination Results, 01 Student was identified as Advance Learner. After the second Sessional Examination Results, 01 Students was identified as Slow Learner For the slow learners, remedial classes were conducted regularly and periodic test and viva were also conducted.

For the Advanced Learners, the Experiential Learning, Participative Learning and Problem Solving Methodologies were carried out. For Example- Journal Club, Group Discussion and Field Visits were organized throughout the year.

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Academic Audit Report odd semesters 2023-2024

(May 2024)

Academic audit was performed by Academic audit committee headed by dean academics at the end of odd semester for all UG and PG courses in May 2024.

In the beginning of Academic year the academic audit committee scrutinized and approved the plan of study duly verified by respective department Heads in accordance with the current syllabus issued by RGUHS.

At the end of odd semester after two sessional exams for B.Pharm and M.Pharm, both are UG and PG courses respectively, were evaluated for Plan of study and lesson plan adherence.

Two departments of The oxford college of Pharmacy Pharmaceutics, Pharmacology related lesson plans were verified for the adherence and compliance with the preapproved Plan of study.

In the department of Pharmaceutics total 5 theory and 4 practical subjects were taught for B.Pharm UG course in odd semester. Out of 5 theory subjects, in all 5 subjects no deviations found in plan of teaching. The respective department was advised to comply with the usage of pedagogy methods mentioned in plan of study. In all other practical subjects no deviation were found from the plan of study.

In the department of Pharmacology total 2 theory and 2 practical subjects were taught for B.Pharm UG course in odd semester. Out of 2 theory subjects, in 1 subject no deviations found in plan of teaching but in 1 subject of I semester, Human Anatomy and Physiology- I, extra tutorial hours were utilized to complete the syllabus. The respective department was advised to comply with the plan of study strictly from next semester. In all other practical subjects no deviation were found from the plan of study.

Continuous performance Assessment (CPA) cards were verified for adherence and the periodic conduct of class tests, assignments and viva voce. There was no deviation observed in conduct of CPA in any of the subject.

The overall result analysis for B.Pharm I semester showed result percentage of below 59% was 6.57% in pharmaceutics -I subject and 4% in Pharmaceutical Inorganic chemistry. Similarly in III sem B.Pharm POC-II the result percentage below 59% was 10%. Based on overall results analysis It was generally advised to all department that the subjects that show more percentage of students below 59% category must be focused with priority to improve through remedial classes.

No deviation in M.Pharm PG course classes were observed in lesson plan and the overall results in all theory practical were found to be 100%.



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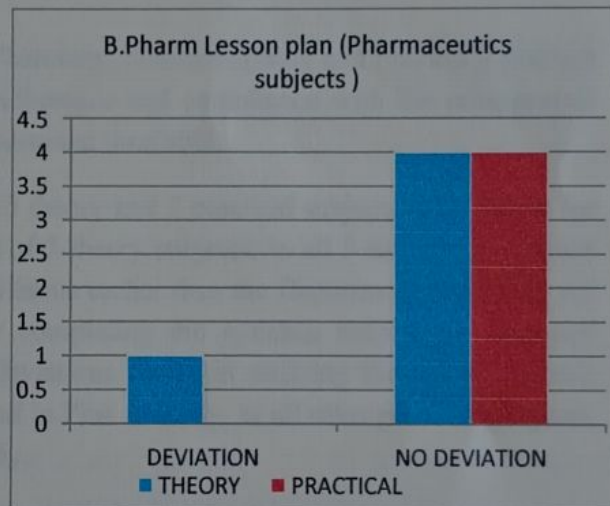
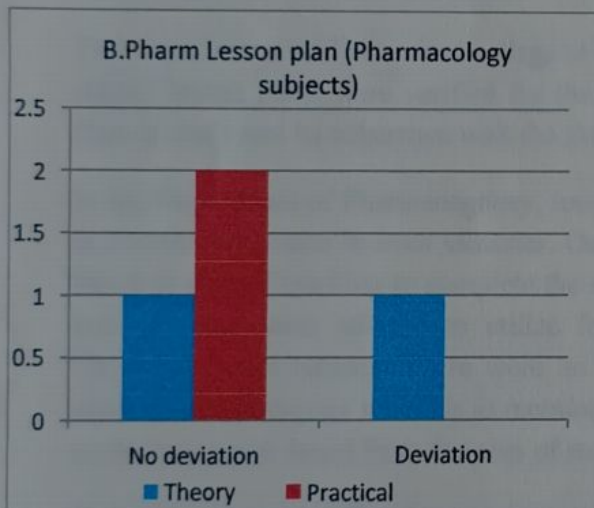
Mentor mentee documents were audited and advised to focus on candidates week subjects in which below 59% results were recorded also focus on attendance percentage of students.

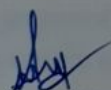

It is observed in general in all subjects, No deviation in Time table for conducting the course. The e-content must be enhanced further and it was advised to all departments that the preplanned pedagogy methods must be strictly followed for all subjects.

The deviations observed in odd semester were brought to notice of all faculty and asked to comply with the plan of study and accordingly corrective and preventive measures were enforced with the approval of dean academics and The Principal.

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Academic Audit Report Even semesters 2023-2024

(OCT 2024)

Academic audit was performed by Academic audit committee headed by Dean Academics at the end of Even Semester for B. Pharm and M. Pharm courses and Yearly audit of Pharm D and Pharm D PB courses in Oct 2024.

In the beginning of Academic Year/ Even semester, the Academic Audit Committee scrutinized and approved the plan of study duly verified by respective Department Heads in accordance with the current syllabus issued by RGUHS.

At the end of even semester after two sessional exams for B. Pharm and M. Pharm, both are UG and PG courses respectively, were evaluated for Plan of study and lesson plan adherence.

Also, three sessionals were completed for Annual UG courses PharmD and PharmD PB at the end of Sep 2024 were also evaluated.

Two departments of The oxford college of Pharmacy, Pharmacognosy and Pharmacy practice related lesson plans were verified for the adherence and compliance with the preapproved Plan of study and its adherence with the Department timetable.

In the Department of Pharmacognosy, total 3 theory and 2 practical subjects were taught for B. Pharm UG course in even semester. Out of 3 theory subjects, in all 3 subjects deviations found in plan of teaching to complete the syllabus earlier than the Department timetable. All tutorial hours were advised to utilize for completing the syllabus before the preponed University Examinations. There were no deviations found in utilizing the student centric methods and pedagogy methods as mentioned in Plan of study. In all other practical subjects, no deviation was found from the plan of study.

In the Department of Pharmacy practice, 1 subject is handled in VIII semester B. Pharm in which the same deviation is found in Lesson plan adherence and early completion of syllabus due to preponed University Examination. But there was no deviation of using ICT tools and student centric methods was found.

Department of Pharmacy practice handled 9 theory and 6 practical for Pharm D and 7 theories and 5 practical for Pharm D Post Baccalaureate. There were no deviations in lesson plan for all annual subjects and it was observed effective utilization of problem-based learning activities in hospital based practical subjects.

Department of Pharmacy practice handle Pharm.D Post Baccalaureate course with 7 theory and 5 practical subjects. There were no deviations in lesson plan for all annual subjects. As there were more than the required hours were available in the Academic year, it was utilized to revise the syllabus.



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Continuous performance Assessment (CPA) cards were verified for adherence and the periodic conduct of class tests, assignments and viva voce. There was no deviation observed in conduct of CPA in any of the subjects audited.

As noticed by RGUHS, in the middle of Academic Year there was a modification in the Calendar of Events of 2023-2024 Academic year. To regularize the Academic schedule preponement of annual exams were announced in the month of October 2024, instead of November 2024. Accordingly, there was a deviation in plan of studies and lesson plans were happened in all even semester subjects. All tutorial hours were additionally used to complete the syllabus before October 2024.

But, this preponement of examination did not affect Pharm D and Pharm D PB annual courses and there was no deviation observed.

In the Department of Pharmacognosy the overall result analysis of at the end of first sessional examination in Aug 2024, it was identified in IV semester B. Pharm Pharmacognosy and Phytochemistry I (BP405T) there were 14 slow learners, in VI Sem B. Pharm Herbal Drug Technology (BP603T) there were 4 slow learners and in VIII Semester Quality Control and Standardization of Herbals (BP806 ET) there were 1 slow learner. The Department had taken extensive steps to improve student performance by conducting remedial classes for the slow learners and later it was observed all were turned into neutral and advanced learners at the end of second sessional examinations.

No deviation in M. Pharm PG course classes were observed in lesson plan and the overall results in all theory practical were found to be 100%.

In the Department of Pharmacy practice, there were no slow learners identified in any of the subjects in Pharm D and Pharm D PB.

Mentor mentee documents were audited and it was observed the department has taken various steps to improve slow learner student performance through CPA and student centric methodologies.

There was deviation due to preponement of examinations in conducting Guest lectures, workshop as it was planned earlier in calendar of events were noticed in both the Departments. The HODs were asked to rectify this delay and conduct programs as per the schedule from next Academic year onwards.

Conclusion:

It is observed in general in all subjects, no deviation in Time table for conducting the course. The e-content and student centric methods were utilized in Curriculum delivery. Advancement in the teaching learning pedagogy were generally advised in all the Departments to meet the goal of achieving expected quality in teaching learning processes.

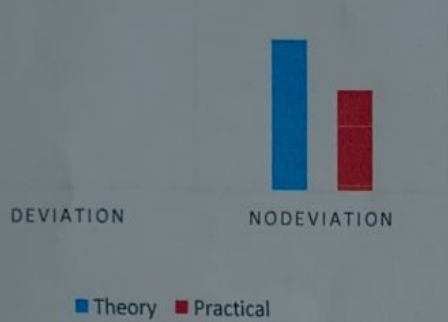


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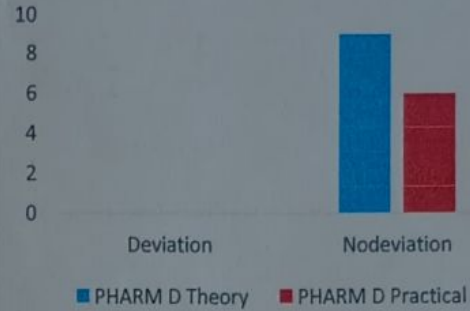
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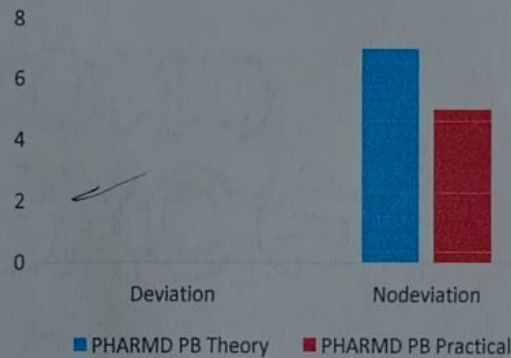

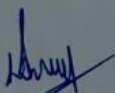


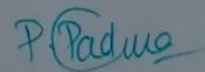
PHARM D LESSON PLAN AUDIT (PHARMACY PRACTICE SUBJECTS)
