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
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
During the year 2023-24 the feedback is collected from students and the analysis report is as follows:

1. The Central Grievances Redressal Committee and the Internal Examination Committee need to be more proactive in handling any issues raised by students during the sessional examinations.






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- 1. The correction of blue-books must be completed within one week and shown to the students.
- 2. Any grievances should be promptly addressed by the grievances redressal committee.




1. The central grievances committee should address any issues related to the lab, common washrooms, classrooms, benches, chairs, tables, and other facilities.






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- 1. Increase the frequency of research meetings, seminars, and journal club sessions.
- 2. Organize workshops on writing research proposals and encourage students to engage seriously with undergraduate and postgraduate projects.




- 1. Require students to complete an internship during the semester break and submit the completion certificate to their class teacher.

- 3. Encourage students to engage in campaigns that raise public awareness about prevalent issues.








