Chairperson discussed & presented the proposed Add-On course to the committee members.

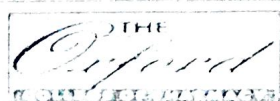
- Total 25 Add-On courses have been proposed, among them 5 courses were suggested by Alumni for the year 2023-2024.

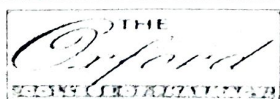

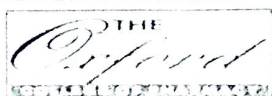
